These awards recognize individuals who have established a positive impact on the Indiana sheep industry, assisting youth and providing services to their local community.

The MASTER SHEPHERD AWARD the nominee must:

- 1) Be a resident of Indiana and a member of ISA.
- 2) Have been involved in the sheep industry at least 25 years
- 3) Presently own or have owned sheep
- 4) Have demonstrated a commitment to the sheep industry
- 5) Have given service to youth and local community
- 6) Have been involved in other agriculture related activities.

The SHEPHERD OF THE YEAR AWARD that nominee must:

- 1) Be a resident of Indiana and a member of ISA
- 2) Presently own sheep
- 3) Be involved in local and state associations and agriculture related activities
- 4) Have developed an innovative idea or service to the sheep industry this past year.

Nominations are now being accepted and will be accepted until September 1, 2019. Your nominations for these awards must be accompanied by a one page typed written support of your nominee. Selection will be made by the ISA Executive Committee.
